IV. REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PARTICIPANTS AND CONDITIONS FOR ACCESS

Persons, exercising aikido, are allowed to take part into the Seminar by prior request, made by aikido clubs, sections and federations.

Minimum age of the participants - 16.

Style classification of the participants - not lower than 2 kyu aikikai aikido.

For the receipt of access to the Seminar it is necessary to provide a private accident policy (sport insurance), identification document, medical access certificate. Specified documents shall be submitted to the credentials committee during the registration of the Seminar participants.

All the participants shall wear traditional aikido uniform.

Participants, having student kyu degree, shall wear white uniform (keikogi).

Participants, having master dan degree (girls - upper 3 kyu) shall wear white uniform (keykogi) and hakama (black or dark blue).

"Participation certificate" (in English) shall be issued to all the participants of the event.
